God's Blessing From Trouble



God sent me ahead of you to preserve for you a remnant on earth and to save your lives by a great deliverance.
Genesis 45:7

So often we ask 'where is God?' when we are going through troubling times. It is natural to feel that God has overlooked our plight when we experience painful or disruptive situations in life. What we learn from the story of Joseph is that God is always at work in our lives, particularly when we face troubles.

Joseph faced some tough times at the hands of his jealous brothers. He was sold to slave traders and brought to Egypt where he was a servant for many years. Isolated, powerless and without love, he trusted that God was with him, even when he was imprisoned. From the outside it appeared that God had indeed forsaken him. But when Joseph rose to power in Egypt, God used him to store up food for an upcoming famine. God allowed tough times for Joseph so that many would be saved and Joseph would be used powerfully by God.

When we face difficult circumstances it is good for us to remember the story of Joseph. It is good to see how he never lost faith. It is good for us to ask God what he is doing so that we can be part of his greater plan. Rather than fearing trouble we can engage with it knowing that God will be at work. Then we will experience the power of our saviour for our blessing.

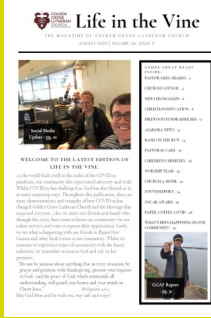
