My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one.
John 17:15

Nothing makes us feel more uplifted than having someone dear to us pray for us. It makes us feel special to know that someone has taken the time and the care to bring our needs to God. Asaroka Update from Jacob Maso



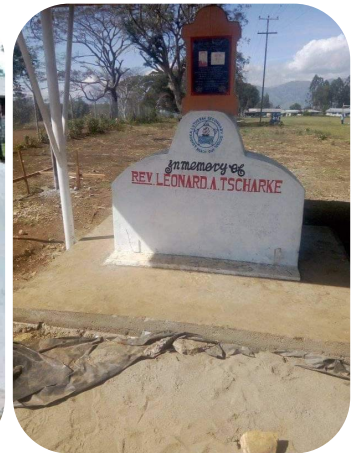
- Asaroka is in the dry season, with only a few light showers occasionally.

Asaroka Rice Launching

On Friday 4th September The Rice Launching occurred with many government officials attending. Today marks an important day for Asaroka when many people turned up. Office of the Prime Minister & other representatives from the province & the district turned up to witness the launching. The Head Bishop of ELCPNG was also present. Government representatives said Asaroka has the potential to raise millions of kina if they seriously take the rice business. It is also a pilot project for schools in the province as well as the nation to venture into such an agricultural program. The government official assured Asaroka Rice Farming their support in finance or technical.
