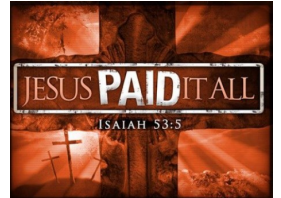

**Easter**

'He is not here; he has risen *Matthew 28:6*

There is no time of year like Easter. Apart from the break from work, the chocolate and the time with family, Easter offers the opportunity of an intense experience of God. From Thursday evening until Sunday morning, our time is shaped by our entry into the Easter story and our soul is refreshed. Our worship is both different and familiar; we have the word of God and we have the sacrament that bring us comfort and joy. We also have times of worship when we are challenged emotionally and spiritually as we encounter discomfort and joy.

When our children were small they would tell us repeatedly that the Maundy Thursday service was their favourite at Easter time. They loved the symbolism of washing feet and stripping the altar. They also loved the drama of the lights being dimmed and allowing the service to prepare us for Good Friday. For other people Good Friday is the most meaningful and holy time to gather as the God's people. And the celebration and energy of Easter Sunday is different to other Sunday services. By the time we get to Sunday lunch we are already satisfied. God has filled us with his Spirit and his presence.

May we all be blessed this Easter.

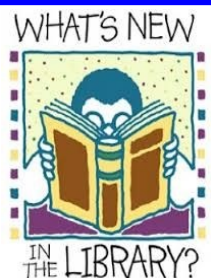

## An outdoor gathering at Ebenezer SA, 21 March 1921: a milestone in the story of Lutherans in Australia.

Battered by years of oppression, Lutherans in Australia emerged from World War I feeling discredited, defenceless and disunited, but also with the conviction that God had been with them in their adversity and was now calling them to overcome their internal differences and seek to become one church under the Southern Cross, united in faith and life and mission. This presentation explores the story of the formation of the United Evangelical Lutheran Church in Australia 100 hundred years ago, focussing in particular on major factors leading to the union of 1921 that was a major milestone on the long path to the eventual union of almost all Australian Lutherans in one church body in 1966. Dr Dean Zweck will be the guest speaker at **Friends of Lutheran Archives (FoLA)** Monday 19<sup>th</sup> April, 7.30 pm at Bethlehem House in the city. All welcome, gold coin donation.

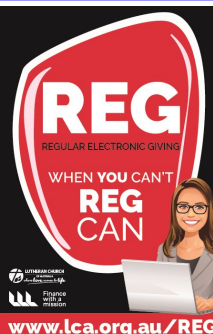
