

Jesus heals

This week's Gospel tells of a woman who after earnestly seeking a cure for twelve years, is permitted to receive healing even without asking and of a child granted healing when her father pleads on her behalf.

Need and faith are the motivating factors for both people to come to Jesus. One is very public and unashamedly begs for mercy while the other surreptitiously steals the gift of healing by just grabbing the edge of His garment. Jesus has time and compassion for both. Amidst Jarius' fears, Jesus stops to seek out the woman who has faith enough to secure His blessing. Finally, unmasked she is given encouragement for her faith and a confirmation of her healing. Despite the delay, Jarius' daughter too is raised to life. Jesus' sovereignty is confirmed in both healings.

Yet, another sort of healing is also happening, becoming apparent when we put ourselves in Jarius' place. Our minds would be in much turmoil. Daring to trust yet with human darts of fear and distrust flitting in and out, each little delay ringing alarm bells. And when Jesus stops to ask, "Who touched me?", you panic. You think, "Why is He bothering with her, she's not on her death bed. Come on Lord, we are running out of time". But Jesus tarries, time is lost. Then messengers tell you that she has died. The loss, the grief, the frustration with Jesus, the feeling of ill-will towards the woman who delayed you. Jesus quickly reassures you, "Don't be afraid, just believe!" Now you are in even more conflict. You so want to believe the Master but your ears are filled with mourning wails. "Jesus said to trust Him," you remind yourself, trying to quell the doubts. Your despairing wife comes sobbing uncontrollably and you must comfort her, so you speak the words of faith that you don't even know if you believe yourself, "The Master said. . ."

Then you are in her room with Jesus and there is this sudden rush of hope, of possibility and before your very eyes, your daughter wakes up and lives at His command. A miracle happens in your heart as you receive a faith healing too. You believe.

Dear Lord, heal our human doubting hearts with faith and trust that we might rejoice in You, in sickness and in health. Amen.

Looking for Volunteers!!

LCA International Mission and Wycliffe English trainer Margaret Borneman are working together to provide an online English program for the Abdi Sabda Seminary in Medan, Indonesia.

From **July 12 to August 11, 2021** the Seminary will be running an English program during their semester break for 200 students. Our involvement will be providing a session (which run from **10.30 am to 12.10 pm South Australian time**) each **weekday**. This session will include an introduction to the theme with a short video or Bible text. The class will then break into small groups, where mentors will assist them to further develop the theme. They will then return to their original larger group for a conclusion.

They need **40 volunteers** to help run the **30 minute** time of **mentoring**, where they work with 5-7 students to enable them to practice their English through structured questions and activities.

If you have a love for meeting new friends, a teaching gift, a talent at working with others, or you just love talking! they would love to hear from you.
