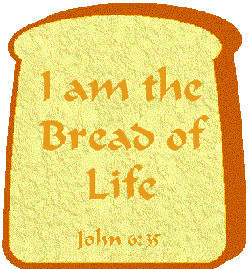
Sunday 1st August 2021—10th Sunday after Pentecost

Jesus, the Bread of Life



Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty." *John 6:35*

When I was going through my 'low carb' fad some time back, I enjoyed the bacon and steak but one thing I missed very much was bread. I was surprised how much bread I ate. In many ways I was conditioned to eat a lot of bread. When I was a boy our kitchen table always featured a bread box filled with fresh bread that I could eat anytime I wanted. If it was morning, after school or late evening, a delicious slice of bread was there to stave off hunger.

Bread was also a staple of first-century diets. And Jesus had just fed a huge crowd with bread that miraculously appeared as he was teaching them. Just as God had provided manna for his people in the desert, Jesus provided food for his people. Jesus was keen to make the point that he is the source of that which sustains for eternity. Physical bread provides for the moment, Jesus provides repeatedly without end.

Apart from making the connection to the provision of food in the wilderness as God's people sought the promised land, Jesus identifying as the bread of life tells us that he is eager to engage intimately with all people. We can talk with Jesus everyday just like we would eat a meal. We can gain energy and strength from Jesus just like food provides physically. May we partake in the bread of life everyday.
