Armed For Battle

We are familiar with the Galatians' list of the armour of God and the exhortation to put it on in preparation for, 'the evil day.' Jesus, Joshua and Paul all assume that we will be involved in that battle. But it is not just an Armageddon type battle. Even if we are not under attack by obvious fiery darts, we are under attack from our own complacency,

Many followers of Jesus found His teaching unpalatable and left, leading Jesus to ask of His disciples, "And you? Would you also leave?" This echoes Joshua's challenge, "Choose this day whom You will serve." His strong declaration of faith resounds, "As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord!" The disciples answered Jesus with similar faith, "To whom would we go? You have the words that give eternal life." Their choice was made.

Paul invites us to make that choice also and gives us practical ways of supporting it. To put on the armour of God, appropriating His truth, righteousness, peace, faith, salvation and Word, all through prayer, is to choose The Lord of Life in the battle against apathy and the fiery darts of the evil one. Then our concern is for the whole body of Christ and we participate in prayer for all of God's people in the battle.

Dear Lord, Thank You for Your armour and protection as we are equipped for battle through faith and prayer. Amen.
