TWO MINUTES

*"I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever – the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you."
John 14:16-17(NIV)*

What do we know about the Holy Spirit?

In John 14, Jesus promises us the Holy Spirit, as a gift from the Father. He is described as the 'Spirit of truth' and we know that he brings people to the truth of God. He is also referred to as a 'Counselor' or Helper. This is a legal term, but with a broader meaning than 'counsel for the defense'. It describes any person who helps someone in trouble with the law. And God knows we are all in serious trouble with God's Law (we call this sin!) I find comfort in the reassurance that God's spirit lives with me and in me. Try reading the above passage again, substituting your name whenever you come across the word 'you'... "and he will give [your name] another Counselor..."

*Dear God, I may not understand much about the Holy Spirit, but I thank you for your gift of the Spirit in my life.
In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen.*

Pastor's Corner



- **Congratulations** to the 16 young people who are making their **next step** in their spiritual journey today.
- It is also a time when they will **affirm their faith**- proclaim what they believe through their "faith story"; **confirm their faith**: state publicly what their parents, godparents and the congregation declared on their behalf at their baptism and so make it their own; and **be confirmed in their faith** (confirmed meaning strengthened, or blessed by God) through the laying on of hands. For this last mentioned rite I am asking the young people's parents, godparents, mentors (if they have one) and any other significant people (ie. people who have been asked by the particular young person to participate in this rite) to come forward and lay on hands as I pronounce the blessing.
- In my address today, based on Deuteronomy 10:12, "**What does God require of me?**", I will relate a sad personally story from which I am sure we can all learn and a rather spectacular miracle which made all the difference in my life and which can give each of us hope. I invite you to allow God to "wake you up" and discover what he requires of you.
- This week I will be away for a couple of days at **District Pastors' Conference**. At this conference we shall be "examining the vocation and well being of Lutheran Pastors in SA" studying "spiritual oppression/exorcism and "communicating the Gospel in the Australian culture" as well a listening to a few reports etc.
- Next week I plan to start a sermon series based on 1 Peter 2:9 entitled "**Living who we are**" to enable us to explore our statement of mission.
- **Jordan Durant** will be **baptized** and Jordan's parents **Nathan and Amy** will be **welcomed into membership** at the first service next Sunday. Also formally **joining GGLF membership** will be **Don & Jean Warren**.
- Also, next Sunday we are our holding our second **Healing Service** (since we have restarted them). You are welcome to join us.
