TWO MINUTES

When your first few steps out of bed in the morning cause severe pain in the heel of your foot, you may have plantar fasciitis (fashee-EYE-tiss). It's an overuse injury affecting the sole or flexor surface (plantar) of the foot. A diagnosis of plantar fasciitis means you have inflamed the tough, fibrous band of tissue (fascia) connecting your heel bone to the base of your toes.

So reads the web site article, and that's exactly what the doctor diagnosed. And they are not joking when they say severe pain – more like excruciating! Even so, you have to marvel at how the body is put together – it's not just a haphazard collection of bits and pieces, but some 30 trillion cells put together in specific order to create our bodies – designed for living. But it's a total package – not only do we have eyes to see and feet to walk, we are also given mind, spirit and soul. Our Creator God gives us a spirit that we may know Him, emotions that we may appreciate and love His creations, and a spiritual life, so that we, as Christians, may live according to His will. And He gives us a soul, a soul that along with our resurrected body shall have eternal life.

Indeed, the body is designed for life, being wonderfully and fearfully made, so that we can praise our Father, and live to His glory, in this life and in the life to come.

Vision is important. It gives us hope. It shows us where we are going -for God, with God and because of God and can encourage us to keep striving when we could stop.

- Our **anniversary service** is in 3 weeks time. Remember we only have one service that day. I am sure it will be a wonderful service.
- I mentioned last week about appointing **Pastoral Carers**: to take up special needs such as integrating new members, ensuring that people (who have asked to be mentored) are being mentored and overall caring for people who could otherwise be forgotten. Probably there are other areas of care needed as well. As I said last week. I plan to be approaching 12 people who I have noticed have this gift of caring to take on this position. But the Ministry Team suggested there might be some people who would like to volunteer for this position. Please see me if you feel as though God is encouraging you to do this.
- Do you remember the **"Micah Challenge"** that was endorsed by our synod last year? One thing we can do to help the poor is to buy products which directly benefit the growers and small business in poor countries. These are called "fair trade" products. Perhaps our congregation could take up this challenge by buying "fair trade" coffee. It's a start.

Hey let's talk about the sermon (Why not use these questions to prepare for the sermon or as discussion starters with a group of friends?)

1. Do you think our statement of vision is important for us? Could be important for us?
2. Talk about your dreams/vision for the congregation. How is God involved in them?
3. How is the Bible verse (1 Peter 2:9b): *kingdom of priests, God's holy nation, his very own possession, a description of who we are and who we will become?*

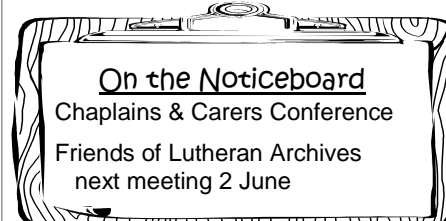
