TWO MINUTES

Gal. 3:23-29. In this Epistle, Paul deals with the standing of the Law (of Moses) in relation to the Good News. In these verses, Paul says the Jewish law kept us from getting into further trouble, like being in protective custody. They showed us what standard of living God required. Alas no one could attain that standard! The Good News is that by believing that Christ died for our sins, God makes us "right" with Him. We are changed on the inside, into God's children.

This Epistle also emphasises the work of God's Spirit in the life of a believer. Not only are we born of the Spirit, but He lives within us, to teach, guide and help us. The Law gave us a glimpse of the standard; the Spirit of Jesus within gives us the power to live as God's children. By faith in Christ we have a "right standing with God" (v.24) and have entered into union with Christ (v.27); the Spirit enables us to live who we are, freed from the limitations of rules and regulations.

Prayer: Father God, thank you for the power of the Gospel of Grace, which changed us from sinners into your children. Help us to listen to the voice of your Spirit, that we may live a life pleasing to You, as did your Holy Son. Amen.

Isn't the Psalmist cry; "What can I offer to the Lord for all he has done for me?" (Psalm 116:12) ours? Stewardship is simply an expression of our thankfulness to God.

• And keep the 20th October free for our **Leadership Retreat**. Possibly we shall be running it at *Wirrimbirra*.

• Why are we promoting these seminars, conferences, workshops, summits and retreats? Remember how I have been digging into meetings where the statement of mission, vision and values were deduced? I noted there was (and I hope still is) a desire to "equip disciples for service", and be "committed to spiritual growth". Is that the case? Let's live who we are.

20th Anniversary Lunch

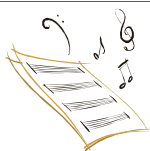
After the 20th anniversary service there will be a lunch so we can enjoy fellowship with each other and have an opportunity to catch up with past members.

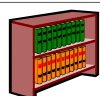
