TWO MINUTES

2 Timothy 1:1-14 Law versus Grace

In this passage Paul is writing to Timothy in Ephesus. The passage is concerned with Paul's instructions to Timothy regarding teachers of false doctrine who did not know what they were proclaiming. There must have been those that were wandering away from teaching of God's love, a pure heart, a good conscience and a sincere faith, using the law as their justification. Paul reminds us that the law exists for the law breakers; those that act contrary to sound doctrine, the gospel of Christ Jesus.

At times it can be so easy to judge others and use the law to justify our thoughts and words. However, we must be mindful that grace should be the primary tool used when we look upon others and what they are saying or doing. As Paul states, we have been the beneficiaries of God's grace that has been poured out so abundantly on us.

It is interesting to note that in the last verse of this passage Paul reminds us of who he was and how he has been saved by our Lord's grace along with faith and love in Jesus Christ. Perhaps we need to remind ourselves of this too, and often.

*Dear gracious Father,
May we never take for granted that we have been saved, not by anything that we may have done but purely by Your Grace. Thankyou for this wonderful gift. In Jesus' name. Amen*

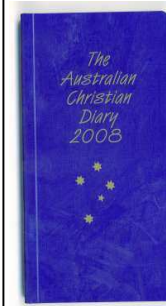
