TWO MINUTES...

Matt 4:12-23

One of the most contentious issues that I've come across through my dealings with children and their parents, is that of discipline. In many contexts today, the word "discipline" is mis-used as another word for punishment. Yet, "discipline" comes from the word "disciple". It means to train to become like the one we follow.

In Matthew 4:18-22, we see Jesus Christ calling His first disciples. "Come follow me!" Jesus said. And they dropped everything – their work, their father, everything they knew – to follow THE ONE they'd been waiting for.

As Christians, we are also followers of Christ – His disciples. Daily we are given the opportunity to reflect, repent, leave everything we regret behind us and start afresh. Daily, we are given the opportunity to follow Christ in everything we do. Daily, we can rely on the Holy Spirit to discipline us to become more like Christ.

Like the first disciples, we have the opportunity to say "perhaps later" and miss what Christ has for us, or immediately get up, leave everything else and follow Him.

- Who would you follow? We are asking that question this morning as we continue our Epiphany Sermon series on "Who is Jesus?" We'll look at various historical and "negative" leaders with this question in mind.

- **Salt Factory** resumes next week.
- **Confirmation** commences also next Sunday.
- **Next Sunday** we are celebrating **Thanksgiving Sunday** by remembering that our vocation and interests are a gift from God. Please note the insert from the worship team today about this service in how you can contribute to this service. The morning service features the installation of the church office bearers and the blessing of the Pastoral Carers as well as presenting our new school principal, Darryl Trigg. Salt Factory features Darryl's installation and the installation of the school staff. The sermon next week is based on the theme: "**A life of thankfulness**", text Colossians 3. I shall be giving part one of the sermon in the morning and part two in the evening. Why not plan to come to both services next Sunday? Actually it would be a good Sunday to bring your Bible as we explore the book of Colossians together.
- Again a reminder about the short course: **What DO you believe?** This course will be looking at the Bible, prayer, worship and the Christian life (serving, giving and witnessing). It will be run on Thursday evenings in February (21st, 28th) and March (6th, 13th) from 7.30pm to 9pm and if there is enough interest during the day (1.30pm-3pm). We are planning that there is no cringe factor: People won't be expected to pray or to read out loud. There will be a lot of opportunity for open discussion. Someone has asked if it is suitable for children. Probably not. Most importantly, have you anyone in mind to invite? Continue praying for them to be receptive to this.
- Keep in mind: **Ash Wednesday**: Wednesday week (6th February)- worship 7pm with the imposition of ashes.
- Also have you put in your diary our church's **Planning Day: Saturday 16th February** at **Wirrimbirra** (Schmoker's block at the end of Grenfell Road), called "**THE GATHERING**". This day is for ALL interested members of our congregation.
