# Pastor's Corner



- Daniel Bartel has a great message for us this morning on stewardship. As he says: *A giving attitude is more important than the amount, whether that is financially or our talents. Whatever it is, it needs to come from the heart. I pray that you challenge yourself with your giving. God so richly blesses us, this is a small way we can say thank you back to God.* He will be taking a few different aspects of stewardship - maybe areas you haven't thought of before.
- Consequently I will be giving a short address along our theme: "**Lord, teach us how to live**". Today it is based on the seventh Commandment which is of course on the area of stewardship. "Listen to find out the positive, life giving aspect of this commandment: "You shall not steal".
- This Sunday we are featuring a talk on **The Food Barn** which is situated at Enfield. I first heard about this at synod last year. What wonderful ministry it is.
- In **confirmation** today we are looking at who Jesus is. We'll be studying him from the Visual Bible as well as our own Bibles.
- **This week:** Ministry Team (Monday), Worship Team (Tuesday), Pastoral Carers (Wednesday) and CCs on Friday.
- We continue the course: **What DO you believe?** by looking at worship. If you have ever wondered about worship, in particular Holy Baptism and Holy Communion and the use of the God's Word in worship, then this is a great opportunity to get some answers: Thursday 1.30pm or Thursday 7.30pm.
- Have you booked into the "**Get Real**" Conference with Michael Foss on 18, 19 April? See brochures and poster. I reckon it's going to be top notch.
- **Next Sunday**, we shall be looking at how important to speak positively as we continue to pray: Lord teach us how to live. We shall also have people from H.A.N.D.S with us. They will be speaking on health and education for East Timor. (see note in this Bulletin.)

### New Data Projector



We have taken advantage of a special price on a data projector, which through a series of price reductions has reduced the price from a retail price of \$3,399 down to \$2,200 in February.
