TWO MINUTES

Do not worry about tomorrow

Matthew 6 : 32-34 "So do not worry, saying "What shall we eat or drink? or, what shall we wear? Your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness and all these things will be given to you as well. Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself."


It is easy to say to others that the Lord will provide, but in spite of some people replying "Oh yeah!" He actually does provide, but often as not, not in the manner we think He might. He provides to us through others and He uses our gifts to provide to others in Jesus' name. We may wonder do we serve enough? Should we do more? If we cannot do more maybe we know someone who can. Then all we need to do is ask. Ask our neighbour, ask someone we don't even know (now that takes courage -pray for it). Ask God and he will guide us.

Whether large or small (little things do mean a lot) we can make someone's tomorrow better in so many different ways. It is rewarding to receive a heartfelt thanks from someone we have served. Not that we are looking for recognition. Remember it is far more rewarding to give than to receive, because we are giving in Jesus' name. To the receiver our help is far more precious to them than we can realise.

My Dad, who prayed every day on his knees at his bedside, always quoted to us four kids "Cast your bread upon the waters and it will be returned to you after many days" – Eccl. 11:1. So let us first seek the kingdom of God and his righteousness.

Prayer: "Dear heavenly Father, show us the way, strengthen our Faith, help us to be more like Jesus, The Servant King. We will then know that we need not worry and can leave tomorrow in your loving hands."
