TWO MINUTES

Matt 9:35—10:8 - Jesus sends out the 12

Jesus and his disciples are travelling through the towns and villages, teaching, preaching and healing people. The sheer number of people wanting to see and hear Jesus touches his heart with compassion for them.

He calls His 12 disciples and gives them the authority to go out in His name to "the lost sheep in Israel" and to preach the message that "the kingdom of heaven is near". They are commanded to cleanse those who are sick, cast out demons and raise the dead.

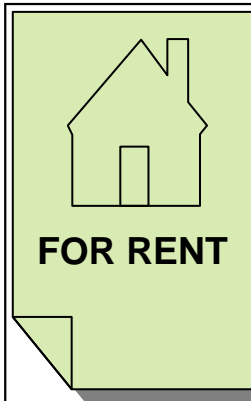
