**TWO MINUTES**

Romans 7:15-25, I love this passage. I think that we can all relate to it, "I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do....For I do not do the good I want to do, but the evil I do not want to do – this I keep on doing." Vs 15, 19.

This would have to be one of the most confusing verses in the bible. It seems like it is going around in circles, but it is so accurate. Have you ever tried so hard to do what is right, to do what you think that others expect? And in the end you fail, because it is not the good that God wants us to do. It is so hard to do the good that we want to do because we have the devil constantly hassling us and confusing us so that we no longer know what we should be doing. As vs 18 says, "I know that good itself does not dwell in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good but I cannot carry it out." It is because of sin that we cannot live the good life that we desire. It is then through Christ that we are able to live without sin, and therefore do the good that is desired. "Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!" (vs 25a)

I bought a picture book that describes this very well and I wish that I could show you it. I will use it one day at Salt Factory, so stay tuned to hear more. Or ask me and I'll gladly show it to you.

*Prayer: Thankyou Lord, that you can help us to do your will. Please be with us always and help us to listen to you and allow you to free us from the restraint of sin. Amen*
