Together in Christ

Sell your possessions and give to the poor. Provide purses for yourselves that will not wear out, a treasure in heaven that will never fail, where no thief comes near and no moth destroys. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. Luke 12:33-34

As fallen humans we have always messed up our priorities in life. We so easily buy into the lie that our worth, happiness and security is found in material possessions and wealth. In our efforts to accumulate wealth we often neglect the things that God sees as eternally important, i.e. relationship with him and with others. This is one of the reasons that Jesus speaks so directly against trusting in money. Deep down we know that Jesus is right. In the GFC, billions of dollars was wiped out in a few days. In Venezuela, immense national wealth has been squandered and the people struggle to survive economically. There is a better way!

God tells us that our main focus is on our relationship with him, receiving his blessing and passing that blessing onto others. He also tells us that investing in relationships is far more profitable than investing in things.

Next week, a team from Golden Grove Lutheran community will travel to PNG to build relationships with our brothers and sisters in Christ and to give and receive blessing. Our school has raised money and made birthing kits to support those who do not have the access to quality medical care that we have. For many years our partnership with Asaroka in PNG has been about focussing on the things that will outlast our plans and our buildings. We pray for God's leading as the team seeks his will for this partnership.
