Before Worship **We are the clay in his hands**
Like clay in the hand of the potter, so are you in my hand. Jeremiah 18:6

Learning is always easier if we have some form of visual aid or comparison to help us understand difficult or important things. A very gifted and experienced teacher once told me that every children’s talk in church needs a ‘prop’; a visual cue that will focus the attention of the children and help them remember. It is no wonder that God uses this in his dealing with us as his people.

One of the most powerful symbols of our relationship with God is when Jeremiah tells the people that they are clay in the hands of God, the potter. It is a statement of fact and also a word of encouragement. God, as the potter, creates and shapes us, the clay in his hands. Just like a potter who gently moulds the clay with skilled hands, God is intimately involved in our life and is at work smoothing the rough edges and creating beauty from ordinary things. The potter’s wheel pushes the clay against the potter’s hand just like the ups and downs of life push us into the arms of God.

As we hear God’s description of himself as the potter, may we be open to his moulding of our life. When we fail, when there are cracks in our wellbeing, the potter is there, smoothing and soothing giving his grace, love and direction.
