Before worship

Would you follow?

We live in interesting times – if there’s something we’re not sure about, we can simply go to the source of all (Dr. Google) and find out the truth: Is this a good deal? Is this the best around? Can this be trusted? As a consequence, we have also become a sceptical society.

In Jesus’ day, there was no Dr. Google to ask for advice – and yet people were waiting for and talking about this Messiah, the chosen one who was to save God’s people. Jesus had been identified at His baptism, by the Holy Spirit, and was now to begin His ministry. Interestingly, when Jesus said “Follow me”, there was no hesitation by Philip or Nathaniel – although Nathaniel did ask “how did you know me?” And given Jesus’ response, he freely followed.

What about you? Were Jesus to approach you today – knock on your door, approach you at the shopping centre, maybe while you were stopped at the traffic lights – how would you respond? Would you drop everything to follow Him – or would you apply some criteria (first I have to...; only if...; well, I can’t on this day/in this place...) to following Jesus?

Following Jesus is not like being a Crows supporter – it cannot be turned off seasonally or only on match days – following Jesus is a life-long commitment, a critical element of each day, guiding your every more.

Jesus has chosen you – Will you follow?

9am Introduction to the Bible

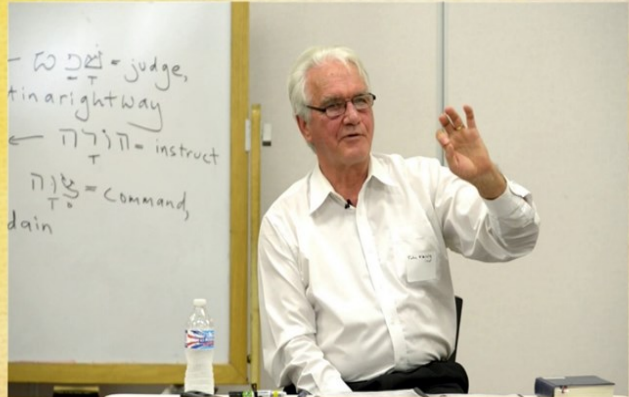
11am The Pentateuch
