### **Before worship**

### The word "transfigured" is a very interesting word.

We hear of Transformers, translations and transatlantic flights – but transfigured isn't a word we hear too frequently at all.

In Greek the word is "metamorpho", meaning to transform, literally or figuratively to metamorphose, or to change. The word is a verb that means to change into another form. It also means to change the outside to match the inside. The prefix "meta" means to change and the "morphe" means form. We see this in the change of the caterpillar into a butterfly.

Yet in Latin, the word "transfiguration" is a noun, "trans" meaning across and "figura" meaning form, or shape, thereby signifying a change of form or appearance.

In the case of the transfiguration of Jesus Christ it takes on both the noun and verb characteristics, by matching the visible outside with the reality of the inside. Jesus' divine nature was "veiled" in human form and the transfiguration was a glimpse of that glory. Therefore, the transfiguration of Jesus Christ displayed the settling of God's glory incarnate in the Son. Hearing the voice of God confirming the truth of Jesus' Sonship was the second time God's voice was heard, the first time being at Jesus' baptism.

The Son of God came to earth in the form of a man to be the true servant of God and to gift mankind with the greatest gift ever given, eternal life. The transfiguration of Jesus Christ was a visible sign in the presence of reliable witnesses of the reality of the power of God and the glory, which is Christ Jesus.


