## Before worship

## **Amazing Grace**

God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it. Ephesians 2:-89

One of the most well-known and loved hymns is 'Amazing Grace'. Even people who are not connected to a church or who don't often think about their relationship with God are moved by the stirring words of this song. It really shouldn't be a surprise because the grace of God is more than amazing. God's grace is something we can barely imagine. More than that, God's grace is what we hang onto as a precious gift.

When Jesus made the claim that salvation comes from faith in Him and not via anything we can do, it was a scandal to those who first heard it. 'How is that fair?' was the common reaction. Surely what we do, how we treat others, what we value must be important to God. We have exactly the same reaction. We want good people rewarded and those who are not so good punished. But God's word is very clear: it is our faith that counts.

It has to be that way. If what we do influences God's favour, blessing and our salvation, then what Jesus did on the cross was not sufficient. But Jesus' death on the cross was all that is ever necessary for forgiveness of <u>all</u> sins, for all time. This is the best news we could ever get.

When we examine our own life instead of looking at others, we see that there are many areas where we fall short of God's standard. There are many times when we take for granted God's blessing and our relationships, and we ignore our neighbour. Grace is amazing because it frees us from the guilt of what we have done (or not done) and allows us a continual fresh start so that we can serve God and others with confidence. As Christians we live by the motto: we're not perfect, we are forgiven.

Imagine being jailed for no reason! At the Friends of Lutheran **Archives** meeting on Monday **19**<sup>th</sup> **March**, Lyall Kupke will tell us about four leading citizens (H Paech, E Heppner, E Wenke, J Wenke) of the predominantly Lutheran town of Walla Walla NSW who were arrested without charge and interned in March 1918. Although one was later released, the other three remained at Holdsworthy camp until the end of the war. Repeated efforts were made to seek justice for them.
