## What about you?

A week ago, we were reminded of the death of Christ, and then His glorious resurrection - for US! But what if you were there? How would you respond? Like the women at the grave - "My Lord, and my God!" or like the disciples - with fear and trepidation... Or maybe you are a Thomas??

What if it happened today? Imagine the stir it would cause on social media - the Snapchat's: *He's Alive!* The Facebook posts: *Look here He is with us!* The YouTube videos... But even with the 'social media' evidence, would you believe Jesus was alive? If you consider the technology used in movie-making, anyone can be made to appear alive, despite being many years dead. So how is it we still focus on Jesus still being alive today? The clue is in the last part of the Gospel: Jesus said to Thomas: "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." And then John continues... Jesus performed many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in His name.

So, as hard as they might try with technology, we don't need to 'see' Jesus to believe He Lives! All we need do is have a trusting faith - and that will give us life. Allyson Dutschke
