Healed in Jesus name

"Through faith in the name of Jesus, this man was healed" Acts 3:16

All of us have heard the name of Jesus used in silly or even profane ways. Sometimes it makes me uncomfortable but I realise that we live in a non-Christian world where people don't really know what they're doing when they use the name of Jesus in ways that do not honour him as Lord.

I wish everybody had faith in the power of Jesus' name. When Peter saw a man who was begging for money because he was unable to walk, he demonstrated what the name of Jesus can mean in the lives of those who have faith. Peter gave the man a life-changing gift; he led him to the holy, powerful name of Jesus. The beggar's plea was for what he thought possible whereas Peter's declaration was of what he knew was possible through Jesus. Healing, renewal and restoration are fundamental gifts that we can receive when we place our trust in Jesus.

Many of us, even though we assert our faith in Jesus was our saviour, are blinkered to what a full life in Jesus looks like. We can become conditioned by those around us who use the name of Jesus as nothing more than an expression of surprise, or worse, a swear word. We settle for a relationship with Jesus that isn't all that life-changing. So we hear the words of the apostle today and we are reminded that we too have the chance to be healed and renewed.

There are always things that ail us. We need healing. Whether it is physical, emotional or spiritual we can be changed for the better because of Jesus' actions in our life. We have the privilege of calling on the powerful name of Jesus in faith to be healed.
