We are used to computers responding instantly to our requests and how quickly we can become frustrated when an aging computer takes an extra 3 seconds to reach its mark!

This 'instant' world can also be a 'small' one. It is 'small' in the fact that it can revolve so much around <u>me</u>. Life can be filled with <u>my</u> needs being met now. Sadly this approach is also prominent among leaders in our world. The media consistently reports on leaders modelling this 'all about me' philosophy of life.


