Before worship

Crossing – on the move from one place to another !

Life can be appropriately described as a journey. We are on a journey, moving from one experience to another, from one chapter to another, from one stage/ age to another.

We often find comfort in the familiar. Surprises are OK, but there's a limit! We prefer the surprises which do not challenge our deeply held convictions and the attitudes formed over many years.

In today's Gospel reading from Mark 4, we find the disciples, the followers of Jesus, confronted with massive changes. This crossing the sea from Jewish to Gentile territory becomes an experience, so profound that the story is still being told today. Perhaps we know this story best as the story of the 'stilling of the storm'.

The context and the fall- out from this miracle is possibly more significant.

I came across this interesting question: Were the disciples more frightened <u>before</u> the stilling of the storm or <u>after</u> the storm was stilled?

Of course they were very afraid while the storm raged, and afraid for their lives. But after the storm was stilled they were 'filled with great fear' v 41. Some translate this as "awe". It was long understood that the sea was outside human control. The chaos found in the raging sea was beyond human intervention. So when Jesus stills it, it means they are in the company, the real presence of God.

What next?
