During September GGLC will have a focus month on Discipleship



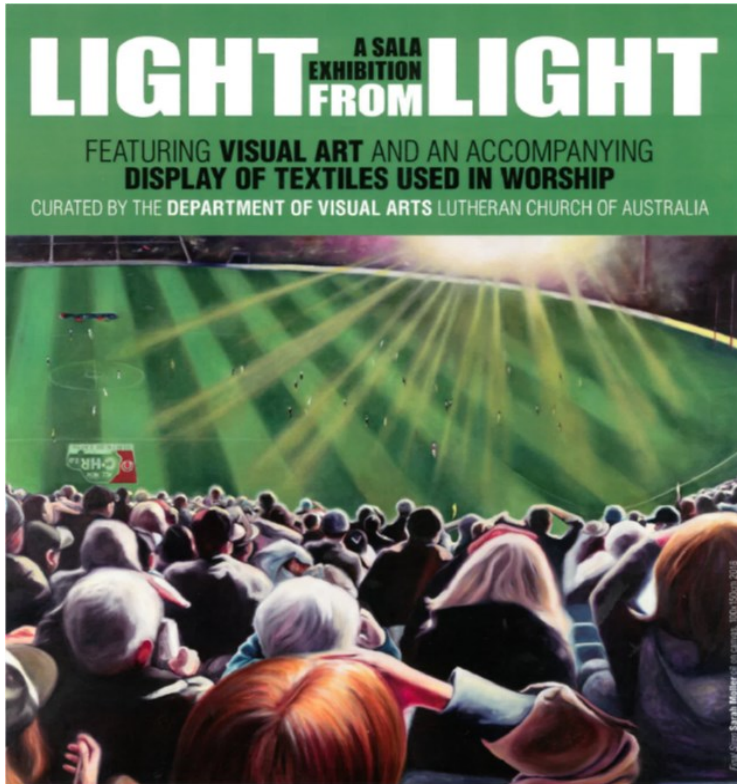
Upside down Circus 2018 Volunteers Required
