God's throne of Grace

Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need. Hebrews 4:16

Thrones are not places that we would normally be allowed to go near, or want to be for that matter. When we see Queen Elizabeth on her throne to open the U.K. parliament, few people are permitted to be close to her. Maybe the Prime Minister or other members of the royal family but ordinary people are forbidden to go near Her Majesty. In times gone by, being at the foot of a monarch's throne could spell disaster as it was often a place of judgment. An all-powerful king could announce your death sentence if he didn't like what you had to offer.

As Christians, we have no such worry approaching the throne of God most high. We are welcomed into his holy presence with love because Jesus has made us right with God the Father. We do not fear judgment, rather we come to God's throne excited to witness his power and majesty, and receive grace. We are covered by the righteousness of Jesus and so we enter the throne room of God as children not subjects.

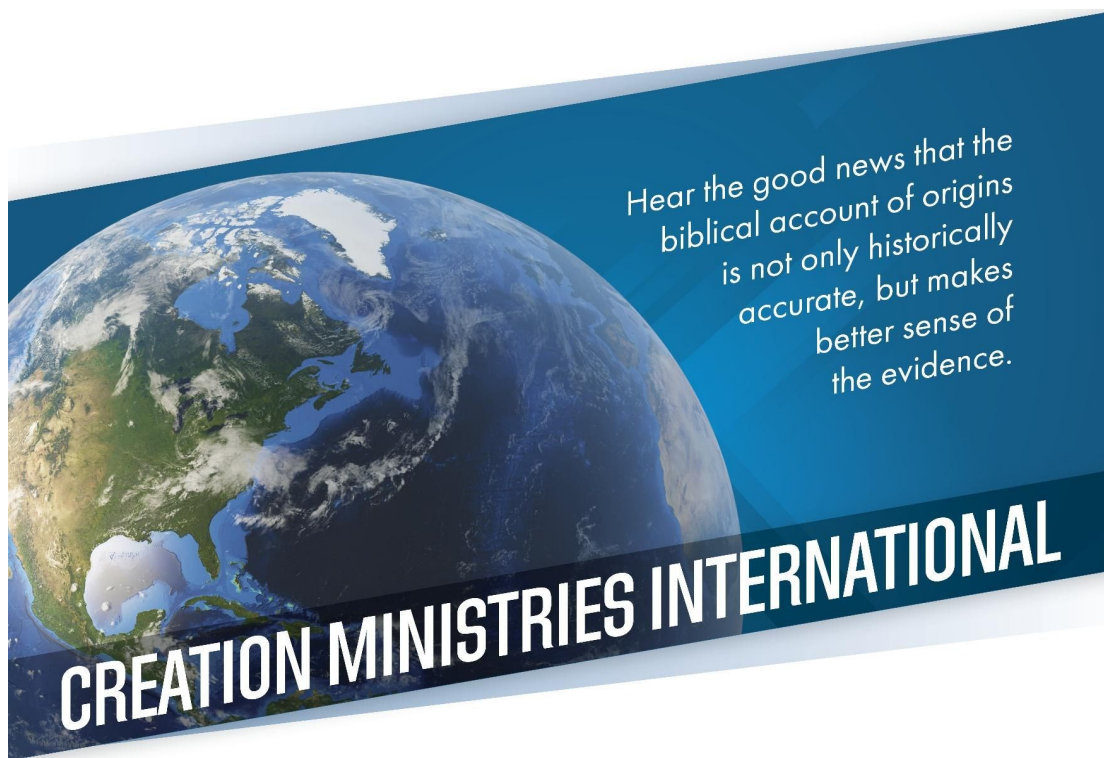
