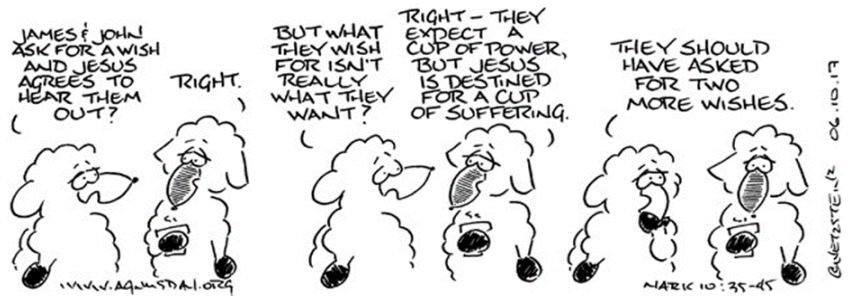
**Servant Leadership**

Whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many. Mark 10:43-45

When I worked in finance before I was a pastor, everybody I worked with wanted to be promoted. Climbing the corporate ladder, progressing in your career, these are things that went unchallenged. Interestingly, few people sought promotion for the extra money; almost always they craved the power promotion would bring. The desire to lord it over others has always been a want of our heart.

Jesus reorients our understanding of what it is to be a leader. Leading is not about exercising power so that we are elevated, rather leading is sacrificing for others so that they are able to be their best. Leadership is not seeking glory for ourselves but for those we serve and for God. When we understand God's view of leadership we see that he calls us to empty ourselves not enrich ourselves. Leading is about putting others first and having the maturity to rejoice in the success of others. May we bless others by serving them as Jesus serves us.

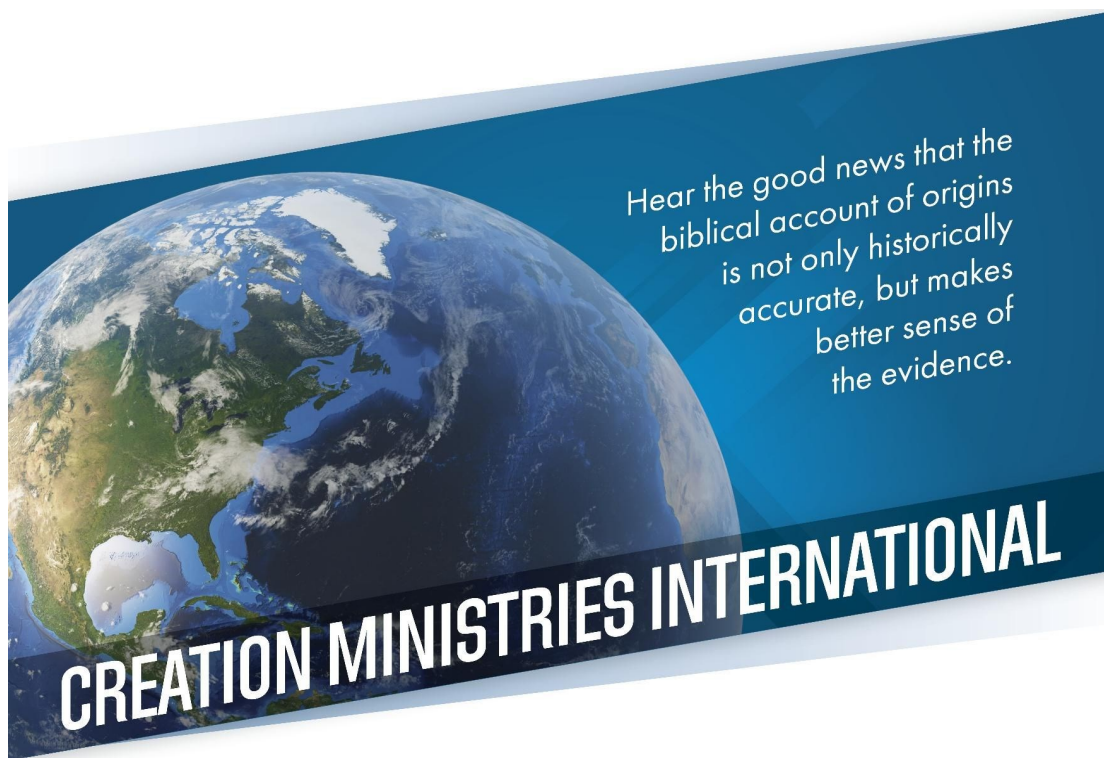
