Before worship

This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased (Matt 3:17)

We were with my in-laws yesterday, and as much as they may not remember other recent details it was lovely for Daniel and his father to discuss the spearing he had been doing at Pondalowie, and challenges with the spear. You could see the pride in the 88yr old's face – I taught him that! Likewise Daniel's mother talking about one of her daughter's making jams and chutneys – you could sense the satisfaction in having passed on her skills and knowledge.

Are you a parent who is proud of your children? I know I am. And it's also a great feeling when your own parents are also proud of you. Whether it's through work, charity, family, lifestyle, academia, it does give a sense of warmth and closeness within families – and across generations.

In Jesus' life, there was nothing significant he had achieved to this point - and yet everything was about to happen...

But then I was thinking of a 'conversation' which may have occurred 30yrs earlier:

Father, "Son, I have a job for you to do". Son, "Yes I'll do it" Father, "It won't be pleasant, I wish there was another way" Son, "Father, I know – and I remember you tried already with Noah and his family" Father, "Yes, if it was only so simple again" Son, "Father, this is what you have been preparing me for. It's time. I'm ready"

Jesus knew the purpose of His life among us – being a carpenter's son, learning to live within society, having friends and family. His normality gave the Triune God a human relationship with people that could not have occurred in any other way. God the Father must have felt incredible pride when God the Son's earthly ministry began – starting with what seemed the simple act of being baptised, but not everyone has a dove rest upon them and a voice name them from heaven. Jesus' true role was about to begin.
