Salt and Light

You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled underfoot. Matthew 5:13

I love salt. When I was growing up my parents would ensure that our salt and pepper shakers were on the table for every meal and it was a ritual that we would all 'season' our food before eating. Mum and dad would sprinkle small amounts of pepper and salt while I would skip the pepper and add a generous amount of salt to whatever mum cooked. No matter what we were eating, the salt brought out the flavour and heightened my appreciation of the food. Even vegetables were palatable with the right amount of salt.

When Jesus says that we are the salt of the earth it is both a blessing and a responsibility. Every person is unique and has their own characteristics. Every person has life, love and hope within them as we are all made in the image of God. But when we are followers of Christ we have been salted; our life is Jesus living in us.
