Before worship

Jesus answered, 'How unbelieving and wrong you people are! How long must I stay with you? How long do I have to put up with you? Bring the boy here to me!' Jesus gave a command to the demon, and it went out of the boy, and at that very moment he was healed. (Matt. 17 verses 17,18)

Jesus could also say of people in our society today, 'How unbelieving and wrong you people are!' Even as Christians we struggle to trust God at all times and in all situations. Sometimes it can even be difficult for us to keep believing in God when faced with a particular struggle. The busyness of life can weaken our faith and take our focus from God.


Invitation to attend events at Australian Lutheran College (ALC)
