Before worship

Jesus the resurrection and the life

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; and whoever lives by believing in me will never die. Do you believe this?"

"Yes, Lord," she replied, "I believe that you are the Messiah, the Son of God, who is to come into the world." John 11:25-27

It's hard when someone that we love and trust disappoints us. When I was a teenager my dad told me that we were going to get a new bicycle for me; a sleek, fast racing bike now that I have outgrown my little boy bike. I was over the moon and I imagined my new bike would be one of those shiny new models that I had seen in the sports stores. When dad drove us to a house to buy the bike I was suspicious. When I saw the 'new' bike I was down cast. It was a used bike that was rusty and dirty with scratches all over it. We bought *that* bike.

Over the next month my disappointment was replaced with pride and love. My dad and I restored that bike to mint condition. It was beautiful. It was a product of dad's love for me. His gift was much greater than a new bike; his gift was his time and investment in our relationship. He knew what he was doing and was prepared to see me disappointed in the short term so that I would be blessed in the long term.

When Jesus saw Mary and Martha after Lazarus had died they greeted him with respect and disappointment. 'If only you were here Lord, Lazarus would not have died' they said. But Jesus could have healed Lazarus from anywhere. He allowed the natural affliction of Lazarus to take its course and Lazarus died. Jesus allowed them to be disappointed because he wanted to bless them in a way that they would never have experienced otherwise.

As Jesus spoke to Martha, his words were truly life-giving. She knew of the eternal hope that awaits believers. Now she knew Jesus IS the resurrection. He IS life. Jesus could have tried to explain these mysteries but there is a good chance that his words would be misunderstood. But now there is no misunderstanding. Their disappointment turns to overwhelming blessing. Faith in Jesus means that we enter life eternal, even now.

Please let either Judith Whaites or Pastor Greg know if you are able to offer him your hospitality for this time.




