Hearing without Listening...

I'm sure that we've all done it before (and will continue to do) – but how often do we become so involved in our own thoughts that we fail to hear when someone is telling us important information. It could be a situation related to our family or a close friend, maybe a work situation – and whether it will be to our benefit (or detriment) we simply don't hear what is being said to us.

As many will know, we're in the process of selling and moving to a new home this weekend, and this could have ended very differently had we not been 'listening' to what was an opportune conversation, but turned out to change our entire plans and gave the advantage when putting in an offer for this new home (that's a whole story in itself!).

Jesus' disciples were perfect examples of hearing without listening to His words. How many times did Jesus try to tell them about who He was, and what would happen? Even when He broke it down into simple language, they still didn't get it! And now He had been crucified, buried, and was alive and walking among them, yet they still couldn't hear what He was saying to them. It took the act of breaking bread in front of them before their ears were opened to what they needed to hear. (Maybe the bread was a representation of the cotton wool Jesus was taking out of their ears??)

Lord, help us to listen to you and truly hear what you are saying to us – You are the Messiah, You are alive, and Your resurrection has given us life.


