Who does not like the 23rd Psalm? It seems to me that as the days creep into years my love for it deepens too. It is so succinct, short, a masterful piece of prose and yet the profundity, the promise, the comfort are limitless.

It is a victory hymn applicable to the whole gamut of human experience. Words to meditate on when feeling low, thoughts to guide us when challenged, comfort even for death's door.

How nice to read that God leads us to the peace of still waters and the rest of green pastures - these are such welcome things in the busy and bruising world in which we live. However, when we read about the protection and comfort proffered in the valley of the shadow of death it is then that we become confident there is nothing in any part of life that separates us from His love, and it takes us right to the house of the Lord for a forever life.

We can leave all doubts aside about who this Shepherd is as our dear Saviour Jesus assures us that He is this Good Shepherd. He is not someone we do not know, but the One we do know, the One we can trust, the Voice we can recognise. The One whose own body stretched across the entrance to heaven and became the sacrificial gate, through which we can all enter, cleansed by His grace and mercy.

Lord Jesus, thank You for the wonderful comfort of this Psalm. We worship You. We thank You. We praise You. Make us faithful sheep in Your flock, rejoicing in truth and sharing its comfort with others. In Your Holy Name we pray, Amen.
