Water Urns Needed Please

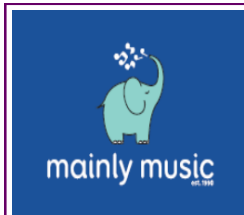
The SA/NT District synodical meeting is being held at our church on **Saturday 20 May** with up to 300 people attending.

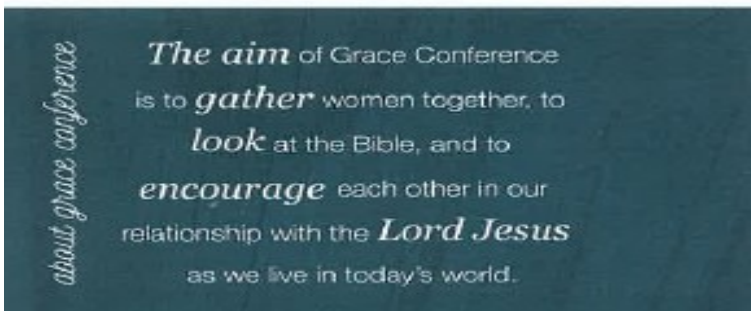
