## The Promise of the Holy Spirit

"I do it!" - "Me do it!" When our children are small, this is a familiar cry as they start trying to assert their independence. But many of the tasks they want to do, they are simply not capable of, or they haven't learnt the skills. Even for something as simple as putting their shoes on or feeding themselves requires assistance from parents and carers, to help them achieve these things.

At the opposite end of life we find a similar situation, when tasks we were capable of doing again become difficult, and we need assistance of family or carers to maintain a level of dignity and control of our life. It seems that in many ways we cannot do it on our own – which for many can become frustrating and depressing.

In a similar way, our life in Christ is not easy – by ourselves, we cannot believe in Christ, or come to Him. As it is written in Luther's Small Catechism: "I believe that by my own understanding or strength I cannot believe in Jesus Christ my Lord or come to him, but instead the Holy Spirit has called me through the gospel, enlightened me with his gifts, made me holy and kept me in the true faith." (explanation of the Third Article).

After Jesus' resurrection, He knew that He needed to ascend to the Father in order to fulfil His purpose, but He also knew that we would need someone to help us keep strong in faith. This is why the Holy Spirit came to us and lives among us – forever, so we can proudly proclaim: "I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen"


The workshop runs for 6 hours
