Pentecost

All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them. Acts 2:4

Pentecost is known for many things, one of which is the 'birthday of the church'. Who doesn't like birthdays? We celebrate milestones with our friends and family like 21st or 50th birthdays where we stop for a while and give thanks for the blessings that have flowed from those 21 or 50 years. So too at Pentecost, we give thanks to God for the blessings that we have received from God's church both personally and as a community.

Many people view Pentecost as the birth of the Christian church because God's Holy Spirit was released for the first time for all believers. This is important because the Holy Spirit makes a difference. Things we would be unable to do in our own power are achievable when we are empowered by God's Spirit. In fact, the miracle of faith in Jesus is the greatest work of the Holy Spirit where we know and experience Jesus as our saviour. Without the Holy Spirit, we may know about Jesus and we may admire Jesus but we would be unable to trust and worship Jesus and enter into his presence. So much of what defines the church is a work of the Holy Spirit.

Pentecost was celebrated by Israel as a thanksgiving for the law of Moses and as a time to offer first-fruits of the harvest. As Christians, we celebrate Jesus as the fulfilment of the law and that by His Spirit the law was now written in our hearts, i.e. we are motivated by love of God and others not fear of punishment. We also see God's Holy Spirit as a gift to us from God. He blesses us with his gifts so that we can bless others.

It's good for us to celebrate the birthday of the church. It's good to see how we have grown in faith and love. It's good to look confidently into the future as part of God's church.

Visit by Cynthia Harbison, June 11

Cynthia Harbison, who is the Pastoral Care Worker (formerly called chaplains or Christian Pastoral Support Workers) at Wynn Vale Primary School, will be speaking at our **Sunday morning service on June 11**. PCWs promote social, emotional and spiritual wellbeing through role modelling, mentoring, pastoral care and structured programs for primary and secondary school students and staff in public schools.

PCWs are funded for approximately 8 hours per week by government, and in our local area additional hours are provided by support from local churches through the Schools Ministry Group of Tea Tree Gully (SMTTG).

In broad statistical terms, for every extra hour, PCWs can support an extra 2 students.

GGLC supports the work of SMTTG through a voluntary offering. On Sunday June 11, envelopes will be provided if you wish to make a donation. Envelopes can be placed in the offering plate on June 11 or any Sunday in June.
