### Before worship

Holy Communion, the touch of God

Today is a special day for our children receiving Holy Communion for the first time. We celebrate with them as they encounter the touch of God in a physical and spiritual way through the bread and wine of the Lord's Supper. Jesus gave us Holy Communion as a gift so that we would never need to be separated from the presence of our Lord and his loving touch.

So many of us know the blessing of a loving spouse. We know that our husband or wife loves us dearly. But knowing it is not enough, we need to experience that love in our everyday lives. We crave our partner's words and attention. We feel secure in their embrace. Knowing about someone and even knowing that they care is not enough for a fulfilling relationship. Our relationships are lived through emotional, physical and spiritual touch.

That's why Jesus gave us Holy Communion. Jesus' love for us, that was demonstrated on the cross, is not academic. Jesus' care and concern is not just words that we read in the bible. Jesus wants to be part of our everyday life and he wants us to feel his touch. In Holy Communion we meet Jesus, emotionally, physically and spiritually. It's part of a healthy relationship with our God. Through this sacrament along with the word of God and prayer we hear God's word, we have his attention and we know him completely.

As we join with our children today in receiving this gift for the first time may our Lord refresh us with his touch. May we see the presence and goodness of our Lord through Holy Communion.
