Isn't it a special thing when you come across someone who is really kind? Kindness is not something that everyone displays. We hear a lot about love and we understand that more as a feeling than an action. But it is not very often that kindness is perceived as just an emotion. It is unseen without kind actions. That's what makes it special. The action confirms the spirit it is given with. An action of kindness is often remembered because it has the impact of being unexpected, of going to lengths beyond the norm.

I love the Bible verse that we read today where it declares, "When God our Saviour revealed his kindness and love, he saved us, not because of the righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He washed away our sins, giving us a new birth and new life through the Holy Spirit."
