### Before worship

Disruption!

I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it. Matthew 16:18

Jesus was never afraid to overturn the norms and practices of his time. If Jesus completed his earthly ministry in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century rather than the First, I'm sure he would have been called a disruptor. These days we call businesses that radically change an industry, such as Uber, disruptors. They cause a new way of thinking and action. With the internet, we are seeing more and more disruptors changing our economy; sometimes for good and sometimes for bad.

Jesus was the ultimate disruptor. Until his incarnation humankind was forced to connect to God through a series of rituals and rules for living. Our sin meant that we were separated from our loving, creating God. So Jesus turns that on its head. His work on the cross means that we can now approach God confidently and without the need of rules and rituals. Our faith in Jesus is all that matters.

Part of this disruption was to bring a new force into being. That force is the church. We, as church, exist because Jesus spoke us into being just as he spoke the universe into being at the start of creation. We, as church, carry the promises, forgiveness and healing power of Jesus to the world. People do not have to stumble in the darkness wondering how to find God. Now Jesus commissions his church so that he comes to all people as the light and life of the world.

Jesus disrupts barriers to God and the kingdom of darkness. Praise God for his disruption.


