## Before worship

Acceptance

You, then, why do you judge your brother or sister? Romans 14:10

At the core of the Christian faith is grace. Simply, we receive God's blessing, forgiveness and favour even when we do not deserve them. Grace shows the heart of God. It shows how our Lord's nature is to give. All he wants from us is our faith in him as our provider and sustainer, both here and in eternity.

Because God accepts us just as we are and asks nothing from us except belief in him, it would be natural to think that we would be inclined to show grace to others. Jesus' acceptance has no conditions. But when we look around we often see a lack of acceptance of others. In fact, as a society it seems that we are becoming more polarised and less interested in seeing the viewpoint of those around us.

Jesus has some harsh words for us when we fail to accept others as children of God. He challenges our right to judge another. In fact, the bible tells us that it is only God who has the right to judge. Our responsibility is to embrace all those God puts in our path and point them to Jesus. We will judge others, even subconsciously. It's part of our human nature. When we are drawn into such behaviour, God encourages us to look to him, to see and receive his grace, to be accepted by him no matter what. When we do, it becomes natural to avoid judging others.




# September is Christian Community Care month
