Before worship

Trusting God

'Don't worry, be happy' is a song that we released in the late 1980s and has been popular ever since. Even though neither of my daughters were born when this song came out, they loved the lyrics and the cool feel of the song. I think part of the attraction of the song is its simplicity in the midst of our complex world. Most of us are born worriers. I have known chronic worriers in my life; people who would invent things to worry about if their life was going too smoothly. Yet in the bible, God asks us not to worry but trust that he is in control.

Today's reading about the nation of Israel worrying about where they will get water in the desert is a lesson about replacing worry with trust. On one hand it seems normal to be worried about a reliable water supply for your family when it seems that there is nothing but a barren wilderness all around. On the other, God had just performed some of the most impressive miracles you'd ever want to see by getting them out of Egypt via the Red Sea so it's unlikely he would allow them to shrivel up in the heat. Much to Moses' frustration the people fell quickly into worry rather than trust. We have that same instinct.

No matter how many blessings we have received from God or what miracles we see in our lives and all around us, we so often worry rather than trust. As the Israelites found out, God had it under control despite appearances. Jesus also warns against worry and reminds us that we are valuable to God and so he is interested in our welfare. Let's encourage one another to see God at work in our lives. Let's remind each other to return to God's word to strengthen our trust when we are prone to worry.
