### Before worship

In Exodus 20 we witness the power and majesty of God as He gave the 10 commandments to His people. The thunder, the noise, the flashes of lightning and smoke billowing from the mountain had the people trembling with fear - so much so that they asked Moses to be their intermediary—they feared death in the closeness of God. Awareness of sin makes us all feel this way.

Moses told the people not to fear because the signs and wonders that they witnessed were God's way of testing them so that their fear of Him would keep them from sinning. Unfortunately a few chapters later in the story, when Moses had been up the mountain with God for many days, the people got blasé to the signs and wonders of God and they demanded idols to worship instead. Fear of God did not stop them from sinning or keep them in faith.

Paul in Romans sets out a better way. No more presenting of sacrifices to idols, no more sacrifices on the prescribed Jewish altars. Rather a presentation of ourselves to God in the here and now as a holy, living sacrifice, where God's renewal of our minds and hearts transforms our thinking. God's law is written on our hearts and in our minds affecting change in our lives to the extent that we learn that God's will for us is good, it's pleasing, it's perfect for us. The faith that comes through Jesus Christ changes us and leads to right worship, the kind Jesus said produces the good fruit the Father yearns. Sin is forgiven and love in our hearts drives out fear.

Let's lean on our Saviour Jesus, offer our hearts and minds in Worship and praise that everyday we may produce the fruit of faith that glorifies the Lord our God.

**12 noon** an opportunity for a get-together over lunch has been organised to be held at the Golden Grove Village Tavern.


