**God with us**

*The Lord replied, "My Presence will go with you". Exodus 33:14*

None of us would embrace a large task completely on our own. We are made for community and to work cooperatively and if significant projects are solely up to us, we can feel isolated and can get discouraged. Most businesses now organise their operations into teams. Employees are now seen as team members, working together and depending on one another. This type of arrangement generally leads to higher engagement and a more positive workplace.

When God asked Moses to lead the people of Israel from Egypt to the promised land, Moses naturally looked for help. While he had Aaron to assist with some of his duties, Moses was carrying the leadership on his shoulders alone. So when Moses received the law and details of the tabernacle, he naturally wanted some help as he instituted new religious practices and transported millions of people to a new land. God in his wisdom gave Moses his Holy presence. With this he would be able to accomplish things unimaginable on his own. More than that, it would be evidence that God is among his people.

We are spiritual descendants of the people of Israel. Today we are his people and his promise to be present is even more real for us than it was for Israel. We have Jesus as God's full revelation. We can relate to God in a personal way that would have been unthinkable for the Israelites. And Jesus has sent the Holy Spirit to live in and with us. The more we realise God's presence and trust that reality, the more we experience God with us.

## Seeking a Producer for this year's Christmas Play

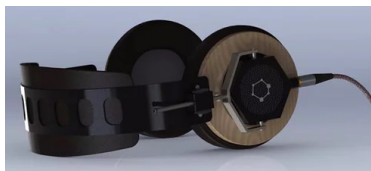
The call is put out for anyone interested in producing this year's Christmas play could you please contact Pastor or member of Worship team.
