Reformation

for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. Romans 3:23-24

According to the Australian Government, reform is the driving force behind all of their actions. A little while back there was a discussion about tax reform. More recently, new media laws were enacted to reform the industry, and right now the Parliament is debating reforms of the higher education sector. All governments use the word 'reform' because it sounds better than change. To reform something is to make it better through change. Sadly, not all of the changes made by governments make things better.

Today we celebrate the reformation of the church. Five hundred years ago, Martin Luther protested against the church's policy of charging a fee for the remission of God's punishment of sins. Luther did not deny the authority of the church to declare forgiveness. He did, however, deny the church's right to ask payment for that pastoral act. Luther appealed to straightforward parts of the bible, like the one above, that declare God's forgiveness is a free gift, given by a loving God. Luther hoped to make changes to official church policy that would rectify this false teaching. But rather than adopting his reform proposals, the church leadership of the time threw Luther out of the church and called for his execution. Luther's teachings were adopted by a number of princes and soon a break-away church was formed.

Anniversaries like this are best served by honouring the truth that inspired the Reformation. The truth that we are saved by grace alone. The truth that it is the actions of our Lord Jesus that guarantees our destiny and God's presence with us. The truth that all God asks of us is faith in him. To God be the Glory!


Pastor Greg holds prayer time at 9.15 am before worship on Sunday mornings.
