**Conversations with children**

One of the truly enjoyable aspects of my work is going into early childhood services and spending time with children of all ages, having some of the cutest conversations about the things that are important to them. And children can be very honest – too honest at times, telling you exactly how they see and understand the world – because ‘my Mum/Dad told me!’

One of my favourite conversations would have to be talking with 3-4 year olds about babies growing inside a mummy's tummy. They have a beautiful innocence and naivety to their understanding, sometimes thinking they can get back inside, or that they have a baby inside their tummy also. There is a simple trusting faith and belief in what they are being told.

In our main reading today, Nicodemus simply couldn't fathom the concept of being ‘born again’, in order to enter the kingdom of God. Imagine if he were having that conversation today – with the available technology and being taught to question everything, how much more difficult, more complex, do we make faith?

And yet, having a child-like faith - that simple trusting faith, is important. Without this we would be questioning, analysing, dissecting all aspects of Christianity, rather than believing, as many scientists would suggest. Celebrate your faith – share it with a child-like honesty, knowing that the Holy Spirit IS at work inside of you – and that it's okay to simply believe (because Jesus told me!).

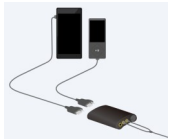
