'Lent is not my favourite season of the Church' my daughter said. This was a few years ago, right after the Ash Wednesday service we had just attended. We discussed which seasons she really enjoyed and she said 'Christmas mostly, but Pentecost and Easter are fun too'. I have to agree; when I think of Lent, the word fun doesn't often come to mind. But I do love Lent.

In Lent, we get an extended opportunity to prepare for Easter.
