Before worship

Before you read my before worship devotion please go to your Bible's and read the following passages. The first reading is from Philippians 3:17-4:1. The second reading is from Matthew 26: 69-76. As you all may or may not know, I am currently studying primary/ middle school teaching at UniSA (I finish my degree at the end of term three this year- so I'm pretty excited). For majority of readings that we are asked to read by our tutors we need to complete a three-two-one. A three-two-one is where you write three dot points that capture the essence of the reading, two dot points on how you will implement what you just read into your everyday life, and one question you have from the reading. I have combined the two readings into one, two, three-two-one, to save some reading.

Three points:

1. There are people on this earth who follow their gods of appetite, they brag about shameful things, and they think only about this life here on earth (Philippians 3:19).
2. God will take our weak moral bodies and change them to be glorious bodies like his own (Philippians 3:21).
3. Peter denied Jesus three times before the rooster crowed (Matthew 26:75).

Two implications:

1. In our everyday lives and ministry groups we do not need to put on a show and focus on things of this life on earth. However, we need to think about how we are preparing people for their eternal life with Christ.
2. Don't deny Jesus to people in our lives. Stay strong in your faith and share the good news of Jesus with everyone who surrounds you. I love the saying 'preach the Gospel at all times and when necessary, use words' (St. Francis of Assisi).

One Question:

1. How can we as a Golden Grove Lutheran Church community work together to share our Christian faith with those around us? Dear God, thank you for your word that we can read and meditate on. Help us to be dedicated and committed to reading your word to fill us up with knowledge, understanding, and faith so that we can then share it with others. Continue to keep us safe, healthy, and close to you. Forgive us when we do not listen to you and have mercy on us. In your name we pray, Amen.
