

## 20th March 2016—Palm Sunday

Today (20th March) is Palm Sunday where we celebrate Jesus' entry into Jerusalem through having branches of palms being carried and placed around the church. I remember when I was a little girl here at church getting excited to see the different branches as it was something different and exciting. As well I remember everyone singing "Hosanna... Hosanna in the highest". Hosanna is used as an expression of praise and joy.
