Before worship

The two readings for this week are from Acts 16:16-34 and John 17:20-26 which I encourage you all to go find them in your Bibles and read them for yourselves (Even find a video on YouTube which explains the story on Paul and Silas, I found that helped me to understand the story better). So in Acts we read about how Paul and Silas had been severely beaten by a mob of people and then thrown into prison. There was a jailer whose job was to make sure they could not escape. On this one occasion, Paul and Silas were both praying and singing hymns to God (other prisoners were listening to these two men too). Then all of a sudden there was a massive earthquake and the jail doors opened. The jailer woke and thought all the prisoners escaped so he was getting ready to kill himself. However, Paul said "Stop! Don't kill yourself! We are all here!" The jailer was amazed they did not run away and then responded "what can I do to be saved?"

Paul said "believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved, along with everyone in your household". The jailer and his family came to Christ (Thankyou Jesus). Amazing how through this situation, God was able to use Paul and Silas to help the jailer and his family come to the faith and belief in Jesus. How does this story speak to you? Can you relate to Paul and Silas? Can you relate to the jailer?

In the gospel reading we read a passage about Jesus praying for all the believers. Great prayer to pray over your situation and where you are currently in your life journey. I know for me, I found reading it so relevant and meaningful. I feel it will now be quite appropriate to end in prayer. Dear God, thankyou for being all that you are and help us to continue to seek you in everything that we do. I pray that we can be like Paul and Silas who never stopped praying and singing hymns and have our faith in you which can then help others to come to you in faith. We also now pray for all those who are followers of you, help us not to lose heart and to trust you in everything we do so that we can share the good news to others in our everyday lives. Amen.
