Speaking the same language?

In my daily work, over 70% of the students I teach are not of an English speaking background, and even though all can speak English (to varying degrees), during the early stages of their study we encounter frequent misunderstandings. At the same time though, I love it when students recognise another who does speak their home language – and they will chatter with great enthusiasm.

In these experiences I reflect on the first Pentecost – where many were gathered and the Holy Spirit blew amongst them like a wind, filling each person, so they were able to share God's word, God's love with all of the different peoples gathered, 'each in their own hearing'. The excitement and enthusiasm when such a combination of cultures and languages were able to experience God's Love, and hear of their salvation through His Word – as had never been experienced before. To all share a common understanding without the fear of misinterpretation – everyone was able to clearly hear the truth of the Apostles message to them.

Even though we all speak the same language, sometimes we have misunderstandings in our life as a church. However one thing we can all understand is God's saving love for us – of this we can be sure.

Getting There: Self Drive (approx 688 km), or Bus (approx cost \$100/person) or Car Pool

Bus Travel – The time of departure will be 8.00 am on Friday **15th July 2016** for arrival at Elliston at about 5.00 pm.
